Fundraising ideas

for Primary Schools

There are loads of ways to get your school and community involved in supporting Keech Hospice. Here are just a few simple ideas we love, perfect for involving families too.

Easy Whole-School Ideas

- **Non-school uniform or fancy dress day** – Pupils donate to dress to a theme such as colours, superheroes, or storybook characters.
- **Loose change trail** – Collect pennies and silver coins to create a coin trail around the school.
- **Cake or bake sale** – Classes work together to sell homemade treats.

Learning and Creativity

- **Read-a-thon** – Pupils set reading goals and collect sponsorship from family and friends.
- **Spelling bee or quiz** – Short, age-appropriate challenges with small entry donations.
- **Art competition** – Charge a small entry fee and display artwork in a school gallery.

Community Events

- **School fete or fair** – Games, stalls, tombolas, and raffles.
- **Bring-and-buy sale** – Books, toys, and games sold second-hand.

Creative Products

- **Class tea towel or t-shirt** – Pupils draw self-portraits or designs to print and sell.
- **School recipe book** – Family-friendly recipes collected and sold to parents.

Perform and Play

- **Talent show** – Singing, dancing, jokes, or magic tricks. Sell tickets to families.
- **Pie the teacher** – Pupils donate to vote for which teacher gets pied.
- **Sports day fundraiser** – Add sponsorship or entry fees to an existing sports day.
