Easy and Popular

- **Non-school uniform day** – Add a theme or colour for extra engagement.
- **Teacher challenge day** – Pupils sponsor teachers to take on dares or dress up.
- **Charity raffle** – Sell tickets with prizes donated by local businesses.

Active and Challenge-based

- **Sports tournaments** – Football, netball, basketball, or rounders.
- **Fitness challenges** – Step counts, skipping challenges, or danceathons.
- **Sponsored runs or walks** – Individuals or teams raise sponsorship.

Sales and Enterprise

- **Bake or craft sales** – Student-led stalls at break or after school.
- **Bring-and-buy sale** – Clothes, books, and accessories sold second-hand.
- **Student-designed merchandise** – Hoodies, t-shirts, or tote bags.

Competitive and Educational

- **Quiz night** – Run inter-house or year group quizzes.
- **Spelling, maths, or subject challenges** – Small entry donations to compete.
- **Sponsored study challenge** – Revision hours, reading challenges, or silent study marathons.

Performance and Events

- **Talent show or open mic night** – Sell tickets and refreshments.
- **Charity gig or disco** – Great for older pupils and sixth forms.
- **Art exhibition or auction** – Display and sell student artwork.
